Important Announcement from the Security Ministry Team:

Recently there have been some thefts to occur at area churches during the service hour. The majority of these thefts have been either stealing the tag off a car, or going into a vehicle that was left unlocked and taking whatever items were left there.

Our Church Security Ministry Team has someone every Sunday to lock the back doors of the church at the beginning of the service. This is a safety precaution since the nursery and children's church are located there. If someone wants/needs into that area of the church building, the only access is through the sanctuary.

Security Team Members will be patrolling the church building and parking lots periodically during the service. These proactive measures have proven to be effective.

We also have the following recommendations:

1. **Always lock your car doors.** The majority of vehicle break-ins that occur are a result of a door being left unlocked.
2. **Never leave valuables sitting out in plain view.** If a thief doesn't see anything worth taking, they may not try.
